## **Notes for Applicants**

1. This application form sets out the standard information which is required for an Amateur Station Licence.

In certain cases, the Commission for Communications Regulation may seek further information or clarification from the applicant.

- 2. To submit a complete application, it is necessary:
  - to complete all sections of the Application Form and
  - to submit the full licence fee with the application

An application cannot be processed until ComReg has received a complete application.

- 3. All new Amateur Station Licences shall incur a fee of €100, with the exception of the following which shall incur a fee of €30:
  - new Licences issued to persons aged 65 years or over on the date of application; and
  - new Licences issued to persons who are in receipt of a Disability Allowance/ Pension.

Proof that one is in receipt of Disability Allowance/ Pension needs to be submitted with the application form in order to be entitled to the €30 Licence fee. (Copies of relevant documentation are sufficient).

Licence Amendments shall incur a fee of €30

- 4. Prior to completing an application, applicants are advised to read Document ComReg09/45 Amateur Station Licence Guidelines.

It should be noted that it is an offence under Section 3 of the "Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1926" to hold wireless telegraphy apparatus without an appropriate licence and such apparatus must not be acquired on the assumption that a licence will be granted.
