 - to submit the full licence fee with the application

An application cannot be processed until ComReg has received a complete application.

- 3. All Visitors Temporary Licences shall incur a fee of €30
- 4. The maximum duration of a Visitor Temporary Licence is 12 months
- 5. Prior to completing an application, applicants are advised to read Document ComReg09/45 Amateur Station Licence Guidelines.
