# An Post Applies to Regulator for Price Increase for international letters 

An Post has applied to the Regulator to change the postage prices of some international mail services to eliminate substantial losses on its international business ( $€ 14 \mathrm{~m}$ losses on $€ 123 \mathrm{~m}$ inbound and outbound services) and to bring its pricing more in line with costs. The proposals include increases in particular on the ordinary letter to Britain (not Northern Ireland) and reductions on other services, in particular bulky packets.

The Regulator, Etain Doyle has invited comments from the industry and members of the public to inform the making of final decision which is due in early December 2002.

The price of a stamp (priority class) for an ordinary POP letter up to 50 g to Britain is proposed to go up to 50 c from the current 41 c , and to Europe from 44 c to 57 c (up to $25 \mathrm{~g})$ or unchanged at $83 \mathrm{c}(25 \mathrm{~g}$ to 50 g$)$. The price for the same type of letter to America and other countries outside Europe will be unchanged at 57 c (up to 25 g ) or reduced from 95 c to $83 \mathrm{c}(25 \mathrm{~g}$ to 50 g$)$. The price of a bulky packet $(500 \mathrm{~g}-1 \mathrm{~kg})$ will be slightly reduced for European destinations - $€ 8.20$ down to $€ 8.00$, and very sharply reduced for the Rest of the World - $€ 15.00$ down to $€ 10.00$.

The increases on the ordinary stamp to Britain and Europe can be avoided by using An Post's economy service.

An Post's international business is made up of the outbound reserved (monopoly area) in which An Post makes losses of $€ 5.6 \mathrm{~m}$, which are offset by very substantial profits in the outbound non-reserved, competitive area of $€ 10.8 \mathrm{~m}$. It makes nearly $€ 20 \mathrm{~m}$ losses on its inbound international mail. Overall the loss is $€ 14.2 \mathrm{~m}$. An Post have argued that costs have and continue to increase significantly in particular payroll costs, delivery and handling charges particularly for destinations within Europe and the impact of September $11^{\text {th }}$ which has resulted in a large increase in air conveyance charges. The proposals made by An Post involve increases in
charges in the reserved area and reductions in the non-reserved area, together with some further movement to format pricing, initiated last Spring. The consultation paper includes a comparison of pricing in a number of other European states (UK, Belgium and Denmark) which show that the proposals would not be out of line with charges elsewhere.

## Note to the Editor

An Post's must obtain the prior approval of the regulator to increase postal prices for services in the reserved area (up to $x$ ). She may examine prices in the nonreserved area to ensure that they are geared to cost. Key issues identified to date in respect of costs are the need to move from pricing based on weight to pricing based on format of envelopes, to take account of the relative costs of automation in processing, and to rebalance pricing in the reserved and non-reserved areas to reflect the differences in costs.
International post constitutes a very tiny part of household expenditure and the impact on the CPI would be negligible.
