1 Appeal of ComReg's Decision on Mobile Termination Rates

1. On 21 November 2012, the Commission for Communications Regulation ("ComReg") published ComReg Decision D11/12 which designated six Mobile Service Providers with Significant Market Power ("SMP") and imposed a number of SMP obligations on each of them, including an obligation of cost orientation.¹ The Mobile Service Providers in question are Hutchison 3G Ireland (H3GI), Lycamobile Ireland (Lycamobile), Meteor Mobile Communications (Meteor), Telefonica Ireland (O2), Tesco Mobile Ireland (TMI) and Vodafone Ireland (Vodafone).

- 2. On 21 November 2012, ComReg also published ComReg Decision D12/12² which further specified the cost orientation obligation imposed under ComReg Decision D11/12. In particular, ComReg Decision D12/12 directed each SMP Mobile Service Provider to ensure that its weighted average wholesale mobile termination rate is no more than 2.60 €cent per minute for the period from 1 January 2013 to 30 June 2013. The decision also imposed a maximum permitted wholesale mobile termination rate of 1.04 €cent per minute on each SMP Mobile Service Provider with effect from 1 July 2013 onwards.
- 3. On 18 December 2012, Vodafone Ireland Limited appealed to the High Court against ComReg Decision D11/12 (insofar as that decision imposed a cost orientation obligation) and also against ComReg Decision D12/12. ComReg will fully defend the appeal proceedings brought by Vodafone.
- 4. It should be noted that, notwithstanding the appeal brought by Vodafone, ComReg Decisions D11/12 and D12/12 remain in force in their entirety. Vodafone is not seeking a stay on the implementation of ComReg's decisions at this time. Accordingly, with effect from 1 January 2013, each SMP Mobile Service Provider is obliged to ensure that its weighted average wholesale mobile termination rate is no more than 2.60 €cent per minute.
