## Mobile Phone Numbers Change to Seven Digits

All mobile phone numbers are changing to seven digits. Existing sixdigit numbers (that is those beginning with 4,5 or 6 ) now have a 2 added as a prefix. This applies to access codes 086,0877 and 088 . See example below.

The change was necessary to create more numbers to satisfy growing demand.

You will be able to continue using your current six-digit number until $1^{\text {st }}$ September 1998. However, from this date calls to the old six-digit numbers will no longer be connected. This is to allow users time to update stationary, signs, databases, etc

This change will not affect current seven-digit numbers (that is those beginning with 2 or 8 ).
