

ComReg closes case where Notice of Intention to Prosecute was issued to Vodafone

Under Section 13D of the Communications Regulation Acts 2002 to 2011, ComReg may at any time, by notice in writing, require an undertaking to provide it with such written information as it considers necessary to enable it to carry out its functions.

ComReg opened an investigation on 18 September 2014 after Vodafone did not provide the information which it was required to provide to ComReg before 12 September 2014 as part of the FACO and Transit Market Analysis.

ComReg gave Vodafone a Notice of Intention to Prosecute on the 22nd October 2014, pursuant to Section 44 of Communications Regulation Acts 2002 to 2011 in respect of the alleged offence.

Vodafone provided additional data and paid to the Commission €1,500. ComReg has now closed the case

ComReg will continue to monitor the compliance of other operators with Section 13D and will take appropriate action as necessary.
