ComReg outlines proposed remedies in the market for wholesale broadband access

The Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) today published its response to consultation on the Draft Decision on obligations proposed for the wholesale broadband market.

The paper contains ComReg's conclusions and response to consultation on the Draft Decision. The proposed obligations on eircom are set out in the Draft Decision and include:

- Access to, and use, of specific network facilities
- Non discrimination
- Transparency
- Accounting Separation
- Price Control and Cost Accounting Systems

In line with the procedures of the new regulatory framework, ComReg is notifying the EU Commission and other European regulators, so that they may comment before ComReg makes its final conclusions.
