1 Update: Discontinuation of licence award for Mobile TV in Ireland

The Commission for Communications Regulation ("ComReg") commenced its consultation process in 2008 to define and potentially award rights of use of 8 MHz of Ultra High Frequency ("UHF") spectrum in the five urban areas of Cork, Dublin, Galway, Limerick and Waterford (the "Coverage Area"). In 2009, a procedure to grant an authorisation for a Mobile TV service in the Coverage Area was consulted on by ComReg² and, earlier this year, ComReg set out details of its proposal.³

As this consultation process progressed, it became apparent to ComReg that use of the identified spectrum to provide a Mobile TV service in Ireland was not the subject of particularly strong interest to potential operators, and interest in the proposed procedure to grant the authorisation diminished.⁴ After careful consideration of relevant submissions, and developments in relation to the authorisation of Mobile TV services elsewhere in Europe, ComReg sought clarification on the level of interest from potential operators by way of publication of Document 10/89 entitled "Mobile TV - Call for expressions of Interest".⁵ It is rather telling that ComReg received only one response to Document 10/89, which is attached at Annex 1, and that the views and reasons given by this respondent accorded with those previously set out by ComReg.⁶

In light of the above, ComReg will not be proceeding further with this matter.

ComReg will, however, keep under review the potential for the identification of spectrum which would enable the award of dedicated licences for mobile TV. In addition, it is noted that any future awards by ComReg of UHF spectrum on a service and technology neutral basis could facilitate deployment of Mobile TV services, subject to the appropriate technical conditions.

ComReg is grateful to interested parties for all their views on the matters raised in the various consultations.
