Inclusion of the 1800 MHz Band into the Proposed joint award of 800 MHz and 900 MHz

Extension of ComReg Consultation 10/105 Response Period

Following a request received from an interested party, the Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) has today extended the deadline for the submission of responses to its current public consultation on Inclusion of the 1800 MHz Band into the Proposed joint award of 800 MHz and 900 MHz (ComReg Document 10/105) to 5:00 pm, on 28 January 2011.

This consultation addresses the potential inclusion of the 1800 MHz spectrum band alongside the proposed award of 800 MHz and 900 MHz spectrum, auction format, fees, interim licences and early liberalisation of the 1800 MHz spectrum band amongst other issues.

ComReg welcomes the views and comments of all interested parties on the matters raised in ComReg Document 10/105.
