Appointment of Adjudicators under section 76 of the Communications Regulation and Digital Hub Development Agency (Amendment) Act 2023

Information Notice ComReg 25/27

1. The Communications Regulation and Digital Hub Development Agency (Amendment) Act 2023 ("the 2023 Act") came into force on 9 June 2023. Among other things, this Act introduced a new adjudication regime for the regulation of electronic communications in Ireland. This regime aims to enhance regulatory enforcement by establishing an independent adjudication process for handling suspected breaches of regulatory obligations in the electronic communications sector in Ireland.

- 2. Under this regime, independent adjudicators, who have been appointed by the Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications, consider cases referred by ComReg Authorised Officers and take decisions on whether an operator of electronic communications networks or services has breached a relevant regulatory provision. If so, the adjudicators will go on to decide on what, if any, regulatory sanction should be imposed on the operator. The sanctions available to Adjudicators include directions to terminate a regulatory breach, orders to pay refunds in respect of overcharging, orders to pay compensation to victims of regulatory breaches, the imposition of financial sanctions and the suspension or withdrawal of a general authorisation or rights of use for radio spectrum or numbering.
- 3. Section 76 of the 2023 Act provides that the Minister shall appoint as adjudicators those persons nominated by ComReg pursuant to section 75 of the 2023 Act, so long as he is satisfied that the persons nominated meet the requirements and qualifications prescribed by the Minister (in the Communications Regulation and Digital Hub Development Agency (Amendment) Act 2023 (Part 7) Regulations 2023) and have the independence necessary to be appointed as an adjudicator.
- 4. On 21 November 2023, ComReg wrote to the Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications nominating a number of people to be appointed as adjudicators. On 15 March 2024, the Minister appointed the following 15 people to be adjudicators, for a 5-year term, commencing on 23 February 2024 and ending on 22 February 2029:
