# 2 **Reference Interconnect Offer Text Change**

### 2.1 RIO Text Changes

### 2.1.1 Summary of Consultation Issues

On the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2003, *eircom* posted a proposed text change of their Reference Interconnect Offer from version 3.2 to version 3.3 on its website thereby notifying all interested parties of the proposed changes in line with Decision Notice D10/02 (ODTR Doc 02/55). Interested parties had twenty one days in which to submit comments to ComReg.

In its proposed version eircom sought to:

- delete Clause 5.2 in Service Schedules 105-110 to comply with D3/02;
- alter Clauses 2.1 and 5.1 of Service Schedules 105 and 205 to reflect the new premium rate service numbering scheme and,
- to insert clarification in Clause 5.2 of Service Schedules 205-222 regarding near end handover.
- 2.1.2 Views of Respondents

No submissions were received regarding the proposed text change.

### 2.1.3 ComReg's Position

The RIO review process is set out in Decision Notice (D10/02) and is most likely to conclude with a consultation following which a direction will be made as regards changes to the RIO text since RIO version 2.2. The following comments are given in that context and the issues herein may be subject to further review at that time.

ComReg confirms that without prejudice to its powers under the relevant laws that the adjustments shown in *eircom's* proposed RIO version 3.3 are compliant with *eircom's* obligations under the relevant laws.
