Notes for Applicants

- 1. This application form sets out the standard information which is required for a Maritime Services Licence.
- 2. Prior to completing an application, applicants are advised to read Document ComReg 11/07 Radiodetermination, Air Traffic and Maritime Serives Licence Guidelines.
- 3. A Maritime Services licence will be issued in respect of a system, or combination of systems, not onboard vessels, using Maritime frequencies for <u>shore</u> based operations, (excluding Maritime Radionavigation and Radiolocation).
 A single licence is issued for operations at specific geographical locations once owned and operated by a single entity.
- 4. An application cannot be processed until ComReg has received a complete application. To submit a valid application, it is necessary to:
 - complete all sections of the Application Form
 - submit the full licence fee with the application.
- 5. All new Martime Services Licence shall incur a fee of €500. Licence Amendments shall incur a fee of €30

It should be noted that it is an offence under Section 3 of the "Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1926" to hold wireless telegraphy apparatus without an appropriate licence and such apparatus must not be acquired on the assumption that a licence will be granted.
