- On 14 October 2016, the Commission for Communications Regulation ('ComReg') notified Eircom Limited ('Eircom') of a finding that Eircom was in breach of its access and non-discrimination obligations under ComReg Decision D05/10<sup>1</sup> (sections 8.1, 9.1, 9.2(ii),14 and 15.1) as amended and further specified by ComReg Decision D03/13<sup>2</sup> regarding access to poles.
- 2. Pursuant to Regulation 19(1) of the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Access) Regulations 2011 ('the Access Regulations')<sup>3</sup>, ComReg has notified Eircom of its finding of non-compliance and given Eircom four weeks from the date of issue of that notification to state its views.
- 3. Regulation 19 of the Access Regulations provides that, where, at the end of the period specified under Regulation 19(1) (see paragraph 2 above), ComReg is of the opinion that an undertaking has not complied with its obligations, ComReg may, whether or not the non-compliance is continuing, apply to the High Court for such order as may be appropriate. Regulation 19 also provides that ComReg may amend or revoke any notification under this regulation.
