

TEMPORARY RADIO LICENCE for use at the 2003 Special Olympics World Summer Games

Information for Intending Applicants

GENERAL NOTES

This Licence application form is intended for all those using radiocommunications at the 2003 Special Olympics World Summer Games.

- Please read the notes below before completing the application form.

- The application form must be returned at least 3 weeks before the event.
- Please ensure the contact person is easily accessible. Some radio systems do not require a licence. Please refer to our information leaflet regarding radio use at the 2003 Special Olympics World Summer Games on our website www.comreg.ie

As a general rule, you need a Licence to possess or use radio equipment in Ireland. Possession or use of radio equipment without a licence is a serious offence which may result in prosecution and penalties or even confiscation of equipment.

Licences are valid for the duration of the Games.

Channels are available in the VHF and UHF bands. See the Appendix for a list of the short-term hire channels available for Mobile/Handportable operation.

You will have to share your assigned radio frequencies with other licensees. All operations must accord with good radio discipline and the statutory Business Radio Licence Conditions, a copy of which will be included with your licence.

Please complete the application form FULLY. If additional information is needed this can significantly delay the processing of the application.

On receipt of this form your request for frequencies will be assessed and a licence will be sent to you indicating which frequencies have been licensed to you.

Please ensure that your licence is available for inspection at all times during the event.

NOTE:

Due to the number of frequencies in use at the different venues all radio equipment being brought into the Games MUST have a numbered authorisation sticker which will be issued to approved licensees by the Special Olympics World Summer Games Organising Committee.

Please note that it may not be possible to permit the use of frequencies in certain bands. Therefore, the earlier we have all the information that we require, the sooner we can advise as to whether or not you will be licensed on the radios and frequencies that you requested.

2. LICENCE FEES

The Temporary Business Radio Licence fee consists of a fixed charge of $\in 12.00$ plus a $\in 12.00$ fee for each radio in the system.

The application fee must accompany the completed form. An application is not complete until the correct licence fee has been forwarded to ComReg.
