1 Notes for Applicants

- 1.1 This application form sets out the standard information which is required for an Radiodetermination (Radionavigation) Licence – excluding AIS systems.
- 1.2 A separate application form is available for AIS systems. Please see ComReg 11/07aR.¹
- 1.3 Prior to completing an application, applicants are advised to read Document ComReg 11/07R3 Radiodetermination Licensing Guidelines.
- 1.4 The Commission for Communications Regulation’s (“ComReg”) issues Radionavigation Licences in respect of a radionavigation system or combination of systems at specific locations once owned and operated by a single entity.
- 1.5 Radionavigation systems may operate in the frequency bands allocated for Aeronautical, Maritime, or Radionavigation Satellite services. Frequency band allocations are set out in the [Radio Frequency plan for Ireland](#).
- 1.6 The licensing process will be co-ordinated with the AirNav Ireland² (“AirNav”) and the Commissioners of Irish Lights³ (“CIL”), as appropriate. Therefore, before applying to ComReg for a Radionavigation Licence, applicants should, depending on the frequency band it is proposed to operate in, contact the relevant body as follows:

- Contact ComReg at: Licensing@comreg.ie to determine what / if any further approvals may be required
- 1.7 An application cannot be processed until ComReg has received a complete application. This may include additional relevant information required by ComReg to assess an application. To submit a valid application, it is necessary to:
- (a) complete all sections of the Application Form
 - (b) attach any prior / conditional approvals granted and
 - (c) submit the full licence fee with the application
- 1.8 All new Radiodetermination (Radionavigation) Licences shall incur a fee of €500.
