

Vodafone given notice of intention to prosecute for failure to provide information requested

ComReg has today given Vodafone notice of intention to prosecute under Section 44 of the Communications Regulation Act 2002 in respect of the alleged offence of failing to provide information to ComReg.

ComReg made the information request under section 13D of the Communications Regulation Act 2002 to enable it to progress analysis of the leased lines market. When the information was not provided in April 2014, ComReg opened a compliance investigation.

If, within 21 days of the date on which this notice is given, Vodafone, as far as is practicable, remedies to the satisfaction of the Commission the matter giving rise to the alleged offence and pays to the Commission €1,500, Vodafone will not be prosecuted for the alleged offence.

ComReg will continue to monitor the compliance of other operators with similar requests made to them under Section 13D and will take appropriate action as necessary.
