1 Application form notes

- 1. The application form at Annex 1 sets out the application procedure which the Commission for Communications Regulation ("ComReg") stated in its Decision No. D13 of 2014¹ that it would publish in early December in relation to the granting by it of a Wireless Telegraphy (Interim GSM Mobile Telephony) Licence to Telefónica Ireland Limited (the "Applicant"), a company with a registered office at 28-29 Sir John Rogerson's Quay, Dublin 2.
- 2. The licence provides interim rights of use to 1800 MHz radio spectrum to the Applicant covering the period 1 January to 12 July 2015, whereupon it shall then expire in full, and is to be issued by ComReg pursuant to the Wireless Telegraphy (Interim GSM Mobile Telephony Licence) Regulations 2014, Statutory Instrument S.I. No. 554 of 2014 (the "2014 Regulations"), which came into effect on the 4 December 2014.
- 3. Amongst other things, the 2014 Regulations set out the restrictions and conditions applying to the Wireless Telegraphy (Interim GSM Mobile Telephony) Licence. In particular, Regulation 4 sets out the information requirements of the Applicant such that the Applicant must:
 - Properly complete all sections of the Application Form (now attached at Annex 1 below)(see Parts 1 and 2 below) by:
 - Providing details of the 1800 MHz GSM Mobile Telephony
 Service Apparatus, which the applicant seeks to be authorised to keep and have possession of, in hard-copy format; and
 - Uploading to ComReg' elicensing website the locations at which the applicant seeks to be authorised to keep and have possession of the GSM Mobile Telephony Service Apparatus;
 - Include full payment for the applicable annual Wireless Telegraphy (Interim GSM Mobile Telephony) Licence fee (see Part 3 below); and
 - Sign the Declaration Form (see Part 4 below).
- 4. The licence fee for the Wireless Telegraphy (Interim GSM Mobile Telephony)
 Licence is €1,362,635.35 for 14.4 MHz duplex radio frequency channels in the
 1800 MHz band for the period 1 January 2015 to 12 July 2015. Full payment
 of the licence fee must be included with the completed Application Form.
